Do you play video games? What about games on your phone? Many people play video games as a hobby. Recently, e-sports have become very popular, with many games available on the Sony PS4, Xbox, and many other \*consoles. Recently, PC games have also improved, with gaming \*laptops becoming more powerful and cheaper, with better images. Not everyone plays video games as a hobby, but probably everyone you know has played a game using their phone or other hand-held consoles. We will focus on hand-held gaming for now. This device definitely increased the popularity of gaming anywhere, and for everyone — I am talking about the Game Boy.

The first Game Boy was released in Japan by the Nintendo company on April 21, 1989. It was released in the USA later that year, but Europe had to wait until late 1990. The Game Boy used features from older Nintendo consoles. This was called the Nintendo Entertainment System, or NES. It was a small box, with a screen, two circle buttons (the A and B buttons), two narrow buttons (SELECT and START), and a direction pad (d-pad). At the top and sides of the Game Boy, there was an on/off switch and a volume slider. There was also a place to use a cable to connect with friends, and a hole where players could use headphones.

Sometimes the Game Boy was sold alone, or in a package with some games. For example, customers could get a Game Boy with *Tetris* or *Mario* included. This was called a 'bundle'. When the original Game Boy became popular, Nintendo also started to make accessories, such as a carry \*pouch, a camera and a printer. The first color was light grey, but other colors soon became available. A popular version was (1)\_\_\_\_\_\_. It had no color at all and users could see the inside of the Game Boy. The original Game Boy was battery powered, and many people praised how long the batteries lasted. This meant users could play games anywhere, for a long time. The first batteries were not re-chargeable, so when the batteries

ran out, users had to get new ones. Soon, Nintendo added a battery charger, and now all Nintendo battery products use rechargeable batteries. The Game Boy became very popular in the 1990s, and was one of many things that helped bring Japanese game culture to other countries. Nintendo still made the original Game Boys until the early 2000s, even though the next version had already been made. The first version of the Game Boy stopped being made in 2003. The original Game Boy began a series, which Nintendo now calls the 'Game Boy family'.

The first Game Boy was released with six games. Four games were available in Japan (2) \_\_\_\_\_\_. These games were Alleyway, Baseball, Yakuman and Super Mario Land. So, Mario has been with the Game Boy Family since the very beginning. But the original Game Boy didn't stay the same. The Game Boy Color was released in Japan in 1998. This was the first Game Boy where the games had color. However, the design of the Game Boy was the same as the original. (3) \_\_\_\_\_ was the Game Boy Advance, which was released in Japan in 2001. Now, the design started to change. Even though Mario was still the most famous Nintendo character, the best-selling games for the Game Boy Color and Game Boy Advance were the Pokémon games (Pocket Monsters in Japan). Pokémon Gold and Silver were the most popular games for the Game Boy Color and Pokémon Ruby and Sapphire were the most popular games for the Game Boy Advance. Then, Nintendo changed direction and introduced the first Nintendo DS in 2004. From the original DS came the 3DS, and, finally, the Nintendo Switch, which is being played by many people now.

And so, the Switch you see now, came from a history which started with the Game Boy. Many people nowadays don't realize how original the first Game Boy was 30 years ago. They also may not realize the influence these old games have had on their mobile phone games now. Even if you are not a gamer, you definitely have seen these games and their characters. Mario is 43 years old on July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Let's wish him a happy birthday together!
